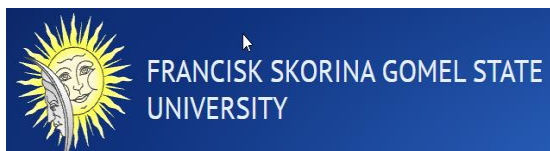

## **Modalities of participation in the conference.**

Participation in the conference requires filling out the electronic registration forms through the web site of the conference (until 1 May 2022), attach an electronic version of the scientific article (the file name, the participant's name in Latin letters indicating the numbers of the sections hyphenated: SokolovAS-3), the author's contracts (for Russian-speaking participants), a document of the clearance for the plagiarism search engines. A copy of a receipt of the conference fee payment must be uploaded in a separate form after a message of the adoption of the article to print.

A document of the clearance for the plagiarism search engines (uniqueness not less than 80%): recommended to go to <https://edubirdie.com> (or any other at your discretion) for English-language content.

It is required that you fill all the fields of the registration form as a participant, an article and a document of the clearance for the plagiarism search engines are attached by the 1st author, the contracts are attached by each author.

The authors are responsible for uniqueness and credibility of the facts and quotes listed in accordance of the law of the Republic of Belarus as well as the scientific content and the presentation of the materials. The content that fails to meet the scope of the conference or its standards or is late for the timescales can not be considered or returned. A manuscript must be reviewed.

The organizing committee of the conference reserves the right of the final selection of the reports for plenary and panel presentations. The conference programme and a link in order to be connected online will be made available on the conference website until 25 May 2022. The follow-up of the conference is to compile an e-collection of the materials with the assignment of ISBN and the registration in RSCI.

## **Organizational contributions**

Organizational contributions include the cost to organize the event, the preparation of the compendium, the package of the member of the conference (with face-to-face participation), mailing of a printed copy of the compendium is not available. Travel, accommodation and food expenses are paid by the participant or the sending organizations. The participants are responsible for their own hotel booking. Conference fee is 25 Belarusian rubles for participants from Belarus (750 RUB, 270 UAH, 8 EURO, 10 USD – for foreign participants). Each publication has to be paid separately. Admission fee is paid after the author gets informed that the article has been accepted by the committee or at one's arrival at the conference.

## **Rules on applications of articles**

Necessary elements of a represented article

1. UDC index
2. Title
3. Names of the authors together with their initials
4. Complete title of the scientific society and/or educational institution
5. Annotation in Russian (up to 5 lines)
6. Keywords (up to 5-9 words in the nominative case)
7. Main text of an article, which includes an introduction, materials and research methods, the results of the study, its discussion and conclusion.
8. Bibliography

UDC should be placed on the left of the front page. Names of the authors together with their initials should be placed in the center in capital letters, but one blank line. The title of the article should be placed in the center in bold, capital letters, one blank line. An organization, a city, a country and e-mail of the author(-s) are placed in the center in italics, one blank line. Leaving one blank line with a paragraph indentation – Annotation and Keywords, the next but one blank line the text is typed. At the end of the text, but two blank lines the title "Bibliography" should be placed. A bibliography itself one blank line from the title is placed in alphabetical order.

## **Style guidelines for the articles**

The articles must contain 2-5 full printed sheets. The electronic copy is to be saved as a '.docx' file in MS Word 2010-2013 using Times New Roman font 12 pt. The size of the margins is: top, right, left – 2,5 cm, bottom – 2,5 cm. Paragraph indentation is 0,69 cm. Line spacing – single. Links are put in square brackets in the form of a number (for ex., [1]), also links to figures and tables are formatted in parentheses as a hyperlink (figure 1, table 1). The bibliography should meet the guidelines of the Higher Attestation Commission of Belarus. Under each figure a caption is provided, in semibold font 12 pt, aligned center. Each table has a caption over it (one line gap between).

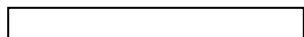
